Texas Pride Disposal is your new solid waste & recycle collection company.

★ ***Backdoor Service Collection Guidelines***

Follow these guidelines to ensure that waste is collected safely and efficiently, to eliminate carts at the curb or on the driveway, and to minimize the time that any trash is curbside.

★ ***Service Days and Hours***

Trash: Tuesday & Friday **Recycle:** Friday **Time:** Please have waste ready by **7:00 am**
Specific collection hours and truck collection routes may vary slightly from time to time.

★ ***Holiday Schedule (Two Days)***

Texas Pride Disposal observes New Year's Day and Christmas Day as holidays.

★ ***Backdoor Household Trash Collection***

- Garbage should be placed in resident-provided containers between 20-95 gallons in size or plastic bags under 50 pounds.
- **It is not necessary to pull the containers down to the curb!**
- Your containers should be placed at the top of your driveway, near the garage and visible from the curb if possible. Those with driveway gates need to place containers outside closed gates to ensure collection.
- **Emptied containers will be returned to where the crew finds them.**
- Trash should not be placed in any container or cart that is labeled recycle.

★ ***Curbside Yard/Green Waste Collection***

Yard/Green waste should be bagged or placed in cans not exceeding 50 pounds. Branches must be placed in individual bundles measuring no more than 3'L x 3'W x 3'H, or tied and bundled and under 50 pounds. Limit 8 bundles per service. Yard waste should be brought to the curb no earlier than the evening before service and no later than **7:00 am** on the service day.

★ ***Curbside Heavy Trash & Bulk Waste***

Texas Pride Disposal will collect two heavy trash/bulk items per service day. Items include furniture, appliances, carpeting (tied and bundled), fencing (nails removed, tied and bundled under 4' in length), and other items not disposed of regularly. Items should be curbside.

★ ***Items Excluded from Regular Collection***

The following items cannot be collected: dirt, rocks, brick, concrete, liquid paints, fuels, oils, tires, pesticides, fertilizer, and batteries. Please contact us to discuss solutions for proper disposal of these items.

★ ***Recycle Carts***

Texas Pride Disposal has provided each household with one recycling cart. If you do not have a Texas Pride cart, have more than one, or have an old WCA or Royal cart that you want to have removed, contact Texas Pride.

Recycle Right with Texas Pride Disposal



Follow the collection guidelines below to properly recycle.

★ Backdoor Service Day

Collection every Friday. Please have recycle ready by **7:00 am**. Specific hours on these service days may be different than they were previously.

★ Collection Guidelines

- Place all recyclables in the container provided by Texas Pride Disposal, old recycle bins, or containers clearly labeled RECYCLE.
- The lid on the new recycle cart says to place it curbside. That does not apply to our district. We have contracted for **BACKDOOR** service and Texas Pride will collect recycle backdoor.
- **It is not necessary to pull the recycle containers down to the curb!**
- The containers should be placed at the top of your driveway, near the garage and clearly visible from the curb. Those with driveway gates need to place containers outside closed gates to ensure collection.
- **Emptied containers will be returned to where the crew finds them.**
- **DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES.** Place recyclables loose in your recycle container.
- Do not place plastic bags in the recycle container.
- Please rinse cans, jars, jugs, and bottles before placing in your recycle container.
