The installation of our 12 Flock Safety Automatic License Plate Reader Cameras is now complete! These cameras are strategically positioned to record license plates of vehicles entering Champion Forest Subdivision, in order to help fight and deter crime.

The cameras are in place, and now recording data.

The data recorded can be mined by law enforcement to identify vehicles involved in crimes or suspicious activity within the subdivision.

The discrete design cameras are solar-powered, the installations look like this➡

Why Flock Safety?



Flock Cameras Capture Vehicle Images

- **Over 70% of crime occurs with a vehicle**, so Flock Safety is able to capture vehicles traveling up to 75 MPH and up to 75 ft away—day and night.
- Cameras are often installed at neighborhood entrances to capture images of all incoming vehicles.
- As they pass by the camera, it captures multiple still images of each automobile. These images do not stay on the local device for long at all.

Footage Used to Help Police Solve Crime

- If a crime occurs, users can give police access to their footage to help pinpoint the exact vehicle involved.
- While doorbell cameras and video security footage can give homeowners a timeframe for when a crime happened, police need explicit, undeniable evidence to improve what they call “solvability.”

Privacy & Usage

- With Flock Safety, you own all the footage, and you decide who gets to access it. No one can monitor the footage because there is no live view. **The footage is only used to help police capture the evidence to solve crime.** And the data is securely stored with advanced AES-256 encryption with our cloud provider Amazon Web Services, where it is automatically deleted every 30 days on a rolling basis.
- If a member of your community does not want their car to be captured by a Flock camera at any time, this is also an option they can select with the **SafeList***.
