Flood Warning System measures rainfall amounts and monitors water levels in bayous and major streams on a near real-time basis to inform you of dangerous weather conditions. The gauges that can be most informative in our area of the Cypress Creek Watershed are:

1160 (Grant Rd & CC); 1150 (SH 249 & CC); **1140** (Stuebner Airline & CC); **1130** (Kuykendahl & CC); **1120** (I-45 & CC); **1110** (Cypresswood east of I-45 & CC, this one can be very helpful as it is just west of the confluence of CC & Spring Creek. In a heavy rain event, CC does not go down until Spring Creek starts to go down/drain quicker into the San Jacinto River); **760** (US 59 & San Jacinto River) The information is accessible via web or mobile devices.
